

Each of these involves sending people to one of many pages based on the value of a variable. This value may be randomly generated by the computer, or it may be based on people's responses to a question.

If the value is randomly generated by the computer, you need to tell the computer the range of possible values. For instance, the code to tell the computer to generate a random number between 1 and 100 would be:

```
$number=rand(1,100);
```

If the value is based on people's responses, the variable should be referred to as `$_POST [variablename]`

The command to send people to a site is:

```
header("Location:http://www.google.com");
```

Thus, assignment to conditions is a set of if-then statements where people are sent to one of several sites depending upon either the randomly generated variable value or on their response to a question.

This code in general takes the format:

```
if (condition) {location command;} 
```
