ACID XPress Checklist

Here is a list of basic ACID XPress skills you should know:

- 1. Run ACID XPress
- 2. Open project or create new project
- 3. Locate loops folder and navigate around it
- 4. Set project tempo and key
- 5. Preview loops and stop preview playback
- 6. Create new loop track
- 7. Enable snapping and set snap grid resolution
- 8. Draw loop
- 9. Change loop length
- 10. Change loop starting position
- 11. Move loop
- 12. Use the play/stop/rewind buttons (also use the spacebar to start/stop playback)
- 13. Change the playback starting position (i.e. move the cursor)
- 14. Set volume for a track
- 15. Set pan for a track
- 16. Solo a track
- 17. Mute a track
- 18. Set project volume to avoid distortion and clipping
- 19. Insert a Marker
- 20. Insert a Tempo/Key Change
- 21. Raise or lower the pitch of a clip
- 22. Save project file as a normal project or an acid-zip file
- 23. Render project as an audio file

Many of the above commands are not exclusive to ACID. Do you know how to do them in the DAW where you work?
